

**GRADUATE STUDENT ACADEMIC STANDARDS  
AND ACTIONS IF NOT MET  
RELATIVE TO GANT APPOINTMENTS**  
**Department of Nuclear Engineering, Texas A&M University**

**Approved 2/25/05**

Standards:

1. A graduate student having a GANT appointment is expected to earn a GPR of 3.0 or better every semester.
2. A graduate student having a GANT appointment who is placed on academic probation must meet the terms of that probation.

Actions:

1. Following the first semester that a graduate student having a GANT appointment earns a term GPR less than 3.0, the following actions will be taken:
  - 1.1 The department will place the student on academic probation the terms of which will be defined by the Graduate Advisor in conjunction with the student's academic advisor.
  - 1.2 The Department Head may modify the terms of the student's GANT appointment during the academic probation including:
    - > suspend payment of tuition and fees
    - > reduce the stipendwith the specific modified terms being defined in conjunction with the Graduate Advisor.
2. A GANT appointment will be continued beyond the first semester in which a GANT is placed on academic probation only if the GANT meets the terms of that probation.
3. Normally, no GANT appointment will be continued beyond the second semester in which a GANT earns a term GPR less than 3.0.
