

Career Center FAQs

Resume Writing

- *I need a resume. How do I start?*
You can find information on resumes on the Career Center's website: <http://careercenter.tamu.edu/Students/S1/S1A.shtml> After you have something written down, you can go to the Career Center (209 Koldus) M-F from 8:30-11:00 or 1:30-4:00 to have your resume reviewed. You may also go to the UPO (209 Wehner) Monday & Thursday from 8:30-11:30 to have your resume reviewed.

Networking

- *How do I learn more about a certain company or connect with Aggies in my chosen field?*
It is always a good idea to set up Informational Interviews with Former Students or professionals in your field of interest to seek information, advice, ideas, leads, & referrals. You can start that process by logging on to the Former Student Online Directory while at the Career Center.

On-Campus Recruiting

- *What is on-campus recruiting & who is eligible?*
On-campus recruiting is the interview process that takes place at the Career Center between employers & current or recently former students. Employers choose which students to interview after interested students submit their resumes through our Aggelaunch online system. All current students & former students (only one semester after graduation) are eligible to submit their resumes to companies, providing they have the correct major & graduation date for that particular employer.
- *When do I need to sign up to participate in on-campus recruiting?*
We recommend students register in Aggelaunch two semesters prior to graduation. It is a good idea to register at the very beginning of each semester, as to not miss any resume submission deadlines.
- *How much does it cost to interview on-campus?*
Aggelaunch registration costs \$35 per semester. You must be registered with AggieLaunch to interview on-campus.

Interviewing Skills

- *How do I prepare for an interview?*
The best ways to prepare for upcoming interviews are to research the company, do practice interview questions, & participate in mock interviews at the Career Center. You can sign up for mock interviews via Aggelaunch.
- *How do I research a company?*
To start, you can go to that company's website to get a general idea of their services, products, etc. The Career Center Library (209 Koldus) also has information on nearly all companies recruiting on-campus. Finally, for each interview, plan on going to that company's informational session. This is a great place to learn about the different facets of that company or industry.
